Taiwan Trip Report

I went to National Taiwan Normal University in Taiwan to participate workshop.

About workshop

The workshop was based on the goal that create an idea to solve issue on educational area by using STEAM education method. NTNU students and Kyushu university students who are the member of the international program participate it.

In the first day and second day, we visited elementary school and high school where introduce the STEAM education in lessons. Then, in the third day, we discuss about the idea in group and in the fourth day, we did our presentation to propose our idea. In the final day, we enjoyed sightseeing with Taiwanese students.

Taipei. The art museum has many Taiwanese artworks and Asian art, like Fukuoka Asian Museum does, and it was so interesting place.
