For our exchange program, there are two categories that students can register. However, once students have selected the categories in their application, they are NOT allowed to change. The two categories are shown below. Please consider carefully before selection.

•Special Auditing Student : This refers to students who want to attend classes and earn credits. They must take at least 14 credits per semester. Transcripts with course results will be issued. • Special Research Student(Master's/Doctoral students only): This refers to students who want to conduct research activities based on their own theme only. In principle, these students cannot attend courses offered in the undergraduate and graduate schools. If they attend courses, credits and grades will NOT be given. Transcripts with course results will NOT be issued.
